

Honor Code Appeals Process—Alleged Violation of Non-Academic Misconduct

Grounds for appeal:

- Conduct Coordinator or Hearing Panel failed to follow procedures of the Honor Code
- Discipline ordered by the Panel is materially disproportionate to the severity of the violation
- New & compelling evidence has been discovered that was not available during original review

Student files “Notice of Appeal” to the Student Conduct Coordinator within 5 working days after receiving notice of final determination of the Hearing Panel

Appeal Panel organized & includes 2 students & 1 staff member

Appeal Panel receives the following:

- All information provided to the Hearing Panel
- Written decision of the Hearing Panel
- Completed Notice of Appeal

Appeal Panel may do one of the following:

- Affirm decision in its totality
- Affirm decision as to responsibility, but modify discipline
- Reverse decision & order new panel to conduct new hearing
- Reverse decision & dismiss alleged violation
